**Instructions for completing this form**

- The Catholic Bishop of Spokane, aka the Catholic Diocese of Spokane, filed bankruptcy on December 6, 2004, and its Second Amended Plan of Reorganization ("Plan") applies to all claims for sexual abuse that occurred before December 6, 2004.
- The Bankruptcy Court set March 10, 2006 as the deadline or "Bar Date" for the filing of proofs of claim by persons who have claims for sexual abuse that happened before December 6, 2004.
- Under certain conditions, a person who did not meet the March 10, 2006 Bar Date may still make a claim for sexual abuse as a "Future Tort Claimant." The Plan defines a "Future Tort Claimant" as a person (i) who knew that he or she had an incident of sexual conduct/touching, sexual abuse, or sexual misconduct by an alleged agent of the Debtor while the person was a minor yet, prior to the Bar Date, failed to make the connection between such incident and injuries arising therefrom, (ii) who, prior to the Bar Date, had not discovered or could not have reasonably discovered that, as a minor, he or she had an incident of sexual contact/touching, sexual abuse or sexual misconduct by an alleged agent of the Debtor, or (iii) who did not reach the age of 18 prior to the Bar Date who had claims for sexual abuse by an alleged agent of the Debtor.
- If you wish to make a claim for sexual abuse and be treated as a Future Tort Claimant under the FTC Compromise Process or the FTC Matrix Process (as explained below), then you must complete this form and submit it to the Tort Claim Reviewer by mailing or delivering it to:

 Do not send it to the Debtor. Do not file it with the Bankruptcy Court. The Plan requires that, when you complete this form, you must elect to proceed under the FTC Compromise Process or the FTC Matrix Process, and give a Release of Claims.
- If you are a Future Tort Claimant and want to make a claim for sexual abuse and be treated under the FTC Litigation Process, then *do not* complete this form. Instead, you must file a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Washington and elect the FTC Litigation Process. If you do this, the Plan provides that your claim shall be allowed either by a trial conducted by the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Washington, or a settlement between you and the Plan Trustee. Your claim is subject to all defenses, including but not limited to the applicable statute of limitations, available to Debtor. Your claim shall be disallowed unless you prove by a preponderance of the evidence that the applicable statute of limitations under Chapter 4.16 of the Revised Code of Washington had not begun to run on or before March 10, 2006. Nothing in the Plan shall affect any right you have to demand a jury trial under applicable law.
- You have a right to consult an attorney of your choice before making your election to be treated under the FTC Compromise Process, the FTC Matrix Process, or the FTC Litigation Process, and completing this proof of claim.

**Claim for Sexual Abuse**

**THIS FORM SHOULD BE USED TO MAKE A CLAIM RELATING TO SEXUAL ABUSE YOU SUFFERED BEFORE DECEMBER 6, 2004, BY A PRIEST OR OTHER PERSON FOR WHOM THE CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF SPOKANE, ITS PARISHES, SCHOOLS OR OTHER INSTITUTIONS, IS RESPONSIBLE. ABUSE IS DEFINED AS INAPPROPRIATE CONTACTS OR INTERACTIONS OF A SEXUAL NATURE BETWEEN A CHILD AND AN ADULT, WHEN THE CHILD IS BEING USED BY THE ADULT AS AN OBJECT OF SEXUAL GRATIFICATION.**

I HEREBY ELECT TO BE TREATED UNDER *THE FTC COMPROMISE PROCESS* AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE RELEASE OF CLAIMS SET FORTH BELOW.  
If you make this election, the Plan provides that your claim shall be allowed if the TCR determines that you have proved by a preponderance of the evidence that you as a minor were Abused by a Responsible Person, and that the applicable statute of limitations under Chapter 4.16 of the Revised Code of Washington had not begun to run on or before March 10, 2006. If allowed, your claim will be allowed in the amount of \$45,000. The TCR shall not consider any applicable statute of limitations that accrued after, or the passage of time after, March 10, 2006, in making such a determination. The TCR may, however, consider your credibility and the facts alleged in support of the claim.

I HEREBY ELECT TO BE TREATED UNDER *THE FTC MATRIX PROCESS* AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE RELEASE OF CLAIMS SET FORTH BELOW.  
If you make this election, the Plan provides that your claim shall be allowed if the TCR determines that you have proved by a preponderance of the evidence that the you as a minor were Abused by a person the Diocese is responsible for and that the applicable statute of limitations under Chapter 4.16 of the Revised Code of Washington had not begun to run on or before March 10, 2006, and does not find that there is clear, cogent and convincing evidence that the applicable statute of limitations under Chapter 4.16 of the Revised Code of Washington for such Matrix Tort Claim had run after March 10, 2006, and before the date you filed your Proof of Claim. If your claim is allowed as a Matrix Tort Claim, the TCR shall determine the amount of your claim by assigning your claim a value pursuant to the Matrix Protocol. The TCR may, however, consider your credibility and the facts alleged in support of the claim and, in the TCR's sole discretion, reduce or deny your claim.

**Release of Claims**

I hereby fully release the Parishes, the Parish Entities, the Catholic Entities (except Morning star Boys' Ranch) and the Insurers, and their respective agents, predecessors, successors, officials, subsidiaries, divisions, affiliates, representatives, attorneys, accountants, and all others acting for or on their behalf (except individuals alleged to have engaged in Abuse) (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any Claim in any way related to my Abuse. I specifically reserve and do not release any Claim against the Morning Star Ranch and against individuals alleged to have engaged in abuse.

I represent and warrant that I have not assigned or otherwise transferred any interest in such Claim.

This Release shall be effective as of the Effective Date of the Third Amended Plan of Reorganization of the Catholic Bishop of Spokane (the "Plan"). Terms used in this Proof of Claim are defined in the Plan.
